Bill Grabe will come to the April meeting to review the Airport Layout Plan. (His father just passed away so he couldn't make it to the March meeting.) We will look at the long range plans after hearing from Bill Grabe and then we can get the applications for state and federal funding.

7. Group Discussion:

Ecker brought up having an air show again for the Heritage Days. He said that the Heritage Days was trying to be part of the Quality of Life Committee for the city of Waverly. Usually the Heritage Days Committee had about \$15,000 to \$20,000 to spend. Ideas were discussed, but nothing was decided.

Beth Collins will be going off the board after the April meeting. The new board member to join the commission will be Jan Johnson.
