OLD BUSINESS

A. UFER – Grounding

- 1) Eventually carrying the rebar up through the basement concrete foundation wall to the top by the seal plate (rim joist area)
- 2) This would be a dryer area from the grounding electrode connection

B. AFCI Circuit Breakers

- 1) Everything will be run through these breakers. Outlets, lighting, smoke alarms & ceiling fans.
- 2) Still not going to require this to be enforced.

NEW BUSINESS

A. ICF Wiring Methods

- 1) Good method for maintaining 1 ¼” clearance. Conduit would be the best method, but will be a lot more costly.
- 2) This is a subject for ideas and thought for future discussion.

B. Home Owners Electrical Examinations

- 1) This is something for the Board to discuss and we can maybe eventually write this into our Ordinance & Code adoption

C. 2006 Code Adoption

- 1) Will need to review Waverly's specific code exceptions. The main thing that will be effected is building & plumbing not electrical.
