We hope to try several methods of lighting the candles including cigarette lighters to see if we can find a more reliable method. Let Kim know if you can help with this project!

We will order the candles. The milk jugs are now stored in the Parks barn and we have enough to start at the Cedar River bridge and light the Trail to the Griggs' crossing and the bonfire.

Our next Trail meeting will be Wed., Jan. 21, 2004 at 7 PM in the City Hall to continue working on the evening ski/walk.
