

GOLF COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

**Summary of Formal Action:** The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m.

**Council Communication:** Council member Reed reviewed the decision by the Council to limit paving of the entry street. Ray reported the Council was in favor of redirection funds from the balance of the parking lot funds to needs on the golf course. Specifically, funds will be used for the south water fountain (\$1,000), additional grow-in labor (\$3,000), and additional grow in chemicals and supplies (\$3,000).

**Regular Business:**

1. **Report on cart storage needs** – Steve Egli, President of WAGOCO, reported that interest in expanding the cart storage is high. An informal survey of interest is being conducted. Egli stated that an option of building a second floor on the current structure has been investigated. Also, a lean to on the present structure is an alternative method.

Ray reported that we have 70 season trail passes sold.

The Club wants the City to keep this need in mind if there is any change in use of the property.

2. **Establishment of June retreat time and date** – Tentatively, Wednesday, June 12 at the Mezanine of the Century Building from 5 – 9 p.m. Ray will contact Klamfoth and Striepe will check his schedule.
3. **Golfers' Comments** -
  - A. High School pass for High School team golfers for season
  - B. One day pass to Club for out of town golfers to be dispersed by the Pro Shop
  - C. Like the first two holes
  - D. Rough in the ditch will remain first cut rough

4. Tour – Superintendent Snook toured the Commission to key areas of the Golf Course Project. He began by showing a cup cutting of an old green and one of a new green. He pointed out the thickness of the thatch layer on the old green as compared to the new. He was pleased with the growth of the new green and the root system. Playing on the new greens would cause irreparable damage at this time. Superintendent Snook assured the Commission that the course will be open as soon as possible.
