- *The Bremer County Fair drew so many people that extra trains were run into Waverly each day of the fair.*
- *The Illinois Central, the Chicago Great Western, the Rock Island railroads and the Waterloo, Cedar Falls & Northern interurban ran at least two runs daily into and out of Waverly.*
- *That in 1908 the light and power engine blew up and landed in the Cedar River. Three local businessmen loaned the city money to replace it.*

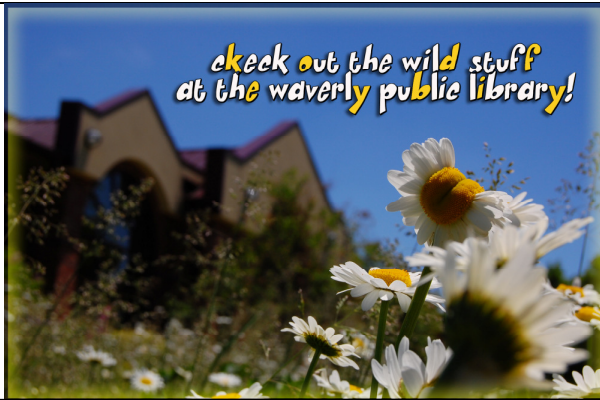
